# Bounty Hunter





A game show where both the players who challenge the game and the ones chickened out have a chance to get the prize money.

The game is played by 5 players at a time.

Once the type of challenge has been described. All 5 players declare simultaneously whether they can succeed the challenge or not.

The challenges are at a level where it is difficult to decide they are feasible or not such as “Pile up 10 empty cans in 15 seconds,” “Succeeding 5 consecutive basketball free throws,” or “Drink up piping hot cups of coffee in 10 seconds.” If the player declares “yes” and succeeds, the players get the prize money. If the player who said “yes” doesn’t succeed, the players who chickened out and said “no” he wouldn’t succeed will divide the prize money.

There are many challenges prepared for the players during a single show, so the one who was good at deciding whether he/she “Yes, I can do it” or “No, I can’t” has a better chance of winning more prize money.

The decision is based not only on the player’s own ability but on his/her perception of the opponents’ characters and talents, and this decision making process is another highlight of the show!



The thrill of challengers saying “yes” trying hard while the ones saying “no” praying desperately for their failures gives a new twist to a challenge game show.
