A physical game and a quiz show using "blocks and boxes in many ways."

A team of 4 members complete in a match game played in 3 stages.

First Stage: pile up the blocks in a chronological order according to the keywords written on each block. The correct order of the blocks as well as the balanced shape of the pile count for the points to be given on the first stage.

Second Stage: blocks in different sizes are passed on by four members to make the goal within the time limit. The game becomes tougher as you are required to do it on a running machine or a horse-back-riding-machine.

Final stage: a 100-cell quiz where each cell has 1 letter valued as 1 point. For each question, the team that comes up with the answer with the most number of letters wins and fills the 100-cell board with the answer. The game continuous until all cells are filled like a crossword puzzle. The team with the most total points earned in all three stages is the prize money winner.



The games in each stage requiring different knowledge and skills played in a visually fascinating block squares make the show attractive to all generations.
